The 15-footer was one of the most popular products of the Herreshoff Manufacturing Company (HMCo). Between 1899 and 1928, ninety-two boats were built to the design. Only the S Boat, with ninety-four examples, and the venerable 12½ with 364 examples, were more sought after. HMCo records reveal that the original H-15 owners included many of the prominent yachtsmen of the era.

ORPHAN was the personal boat of the late Dave Corcoran. Dave and his Bullhouse Boatworks are renowned for the authentic reproductions of many of the Herreshoff one-designs of the highest quality. The 15 was Dave's specialty, and Bullhouse built about a dozen of these boats. He built *ORPHAN* in 2005, and she has been stored inside since 2007.



Dave's family is reluctantly offering *ORPHAN* for sale for \$46,500. She will have received all of her spring maintenance, is launch ready, and comes with a custom-fit trailer. Delivery, launching, and rigging available.
