WANDA is one of the finest remaining examples of the renowned Herreshoff Fish Class. The Fish was designed by Nat Herreshoff in 1916 as a big sister to the 12½. WANDA was built in 1925 or 1926 and most likely was raced in her early years at

the Warwick Country Club in Rhode Island. She then went south to compete in the Long Island regattas.

By 2005, she was in need of a facelift and was completely restored by the well known firm of McClave, Philbrick, and Giblin of Mystic, CT. Today, she is kept in immaculate condition in Nantucket.

Her owner has decided to offer WANDA at \$75,000 as he is moving to a cruising yacht. Included in this price are a custom Triad trailer and a complete set of sails and rigging.
